In the framework of a two-day-event focusing on of the creation of spin-offs, the <u>VIADUCT project</u> organises an Interregional Thematic Workshop & Site Visit to address useful actions aimed at supporting the steps to move from the research results to the market.

The event addresses the semester's theme: funding and financing mechanisms of spin-off creation. It allows a space for discussion and sharing of European Good Practices and/or Regional Challenges on the implementation and sustainability of funding models for spin-off ventures, fostering collaboration between stakeholders, and exploring innovative strategies to overcome financial barriers in the commercialization of research and technology.
